

*The Armenian Amiras of the Ottoman Empire*, is the late Hagop L. Barsoumian's 1980 Doctoral dissertation "The Armenian *Amira* Class of Istanbul" at Columbia University. It is the first academic research ever done on the wealthy and powerful Ottoman Armenians, who from the mid-eighteenth to the nineteenth century played a significant role in the Empire and imposed their political leadership to the Armenian *millet*. IRIS PAPA-ZIAN did the English editing of the original version.
